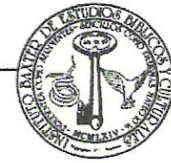

Helen had a great effect on the lives of all the Baxter students when the school was in Mexico. She and her husband James were largely responsible for Harris going to Mexico in the early '60s. Helen and James, her husband, were also an important part of La Voz Eterna first, then Baxter. Helen wrote for La Voz and also taught at Baxter.
